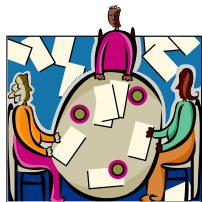
OTHER FUNDRAISERS: Several restaurant nights are in the planning process; stay tuned to the listserv for information.
