Request Description:	Historically, Poms parents have paid for the annual purchase of the metallic Poms that are used by the Poms Squad. We are respectfully requesting that since Poms are required in order for the Squad to perform at football and basketball games, Pep Rallies and the New Student Picnic, this expenditure be paid for by the Booster Club. Typically, a set of Poms only lasts one season as they begin to show wear and tear after use over a six month period which begins with practices in August and ends with competitions in February. We pay a discounted rate of \$36 per pair of Poms. This year with 14 Squad members, the total is \$504.
